Completing the coursework

You may take the courses in any order you choose, however you should note the column called "semester". If there is a semester listed here, that is the only semester a course is offered.

We encourage you to take your MUEP coursework first. MUEP has a program fee of \$1,250 per semester which is charged in addition to ASU's Graduate Tuition and Fees. By completing the MUEP coursework first, you will not be charged the program fee while you complete your MPP. **To complete the MUEP curriculum you will want to take all courses in "MUEP Coursework" and "Shared Coursework".**

Culminating Experience

You will need to complete a culminating experience for each program. For MPP, you will take the Public Affairs Capstone and for MUEP, you will have the opportunity to choose between:

- PUP 599: Thesis (6)
