

The Master of Urban and Environmental Planning (MUEP) Accelerated Degree program allows students to fast track the Master's program. Undergraduate students may take up to 12 credit hours of graduate coursework in their senior year.

The below curriculum outlines the requirements of the MUEP program. All graduate coursework should be taken in the order described. If students need to deviate from the below plan, contact the Graduate Advisor to review options.

<sup>1</sup> Students have the option to move their graduate year start term to summer, provided that all undergraduate degree requirements are met and the bachelor's degree is conferred in spring. In this case, students may take up to 6.0 elective credits during the summer and reduce the course load in the graduate year to 15.0 credits in fall and 14.0 or 15.0 credits in spring. \* Refer to *Approved MUEP Electives List* for approved electives. A maximum of 6.0 credits 400-level coursework may be taken as electives after starting the graduate program. 400-level coursework taken during the senior year is **not** eligible to be applied toward the MUEP degree.

\*\*\* Culminating experience options are a traditional capstone PUP 580 Planning Workshop (5.0 credits), a professional project PUP 593 Applied Project (5.0 credits), or a thesis PUP 599 Thesis (6.0 credits).
