Functions, duties, and responsibilities (Economic & GIS Tracks):

- Research and analysis using the aLocal Al Platform, primary and secondary sources;
- Develop secondary research resources (e.g. online surveys);
- Draft proposals and reports for planning, land use, financial analysis, economic development and comprehensive plan;
- Support the development review process through stakeholder communication and process documentation;
- Support site plan review discussions and process;
- Coordinate, attend and support client, public, and other meetings;
- Supporting marketing by attending events and other related meetings, social media support and positive promotion of aLocal, its mission, clients, partners, and team members;
- Provide support on white papers with economic and financial research and analysis (ECONOMIC/PLANNING ONLY)
- Provide GIS support and creation of GIS graphics, maps, etc. as needed (GIS ONLY);

- Performs additional duties as required.

Preferred/Required Knowledge, Skills, and Qualifications:

- Ability to use these software applications:
 - o Required: Excel, Word, Power Point, Google Earth, Adobe;
 - o Advantageous: aLocal netEI, other related software packages; and
 - GIS track only: proficiency in software like ArcGIS required.
- Strong verbal and written communication are required.
- Ability to work independently and multitask are required.
- Ability to conduct in-person and virtual public participation activities, meetings, and hearings are required.
- Knowledge of planning theory and practice and/or basic urban planning principles is highly advantageous.
- Knowledge of Native nations culture and/or experiences working with Native nations and the relevant planning techniques is advantageous.
- Experience with grants writing or administration is not required, but advantageous.



Education, Experience, Certifications and Licenses Required:

- Bachelor's degree in Economics, Finance, Planning, GIS or closely related field;
- Master's Degree (in progress or completed) in related field is preferred; and
- Six months of experience or internship in a research/analysis or planning/economic development function is preferred.

Compensation:

- This is an individual contract so the individual would receive a stipend and be responsible for a W-9 and receive a 1099 form at the end of the tax year.
- Compensation would for \$25 per hour up to \$2,000 per month total.

Conditions:

- Interns may use the aLocal office in Tempe for work, but, as a contractor, the work can be done fully remotely.
- We may require attendance at some client meetings.
- Must dress professionally when meeting with clients, other aLocal representatives, stakeholders, and partners (virtually or in-person).
- Some overnight travel may be required.
- Must have reliable internet, computer, and cell phone.
- Work may require off-site meetings and reliable transportation is required.
